KENYA RWI Announcement No.20 – Singapore Inspections

This document provides information for those stakeholders requiring the mandatory vehicle pre-shipment Roadworthiness Inspection (RWI) for export to Kenya from Singapore.

JEVIC SG Pte. Ltd., a subsidiary of Japan Export Vehicle Inspection Center Co. Ltd. (JEVIC) a Japan registered company, is the service provider for Kenya Roadworthiness Inspections as of the 15th December 2008 (reference KEBS announcement PRE-EXPORT VERIFICATION OF CONFORMITY (PVoC) TO STANDARDS PROGRAMME 2135473). All fees and inspection criteria are regulated by the Kenya Bureau of Standards. Please direct all enquires to JEVIC SG Pte. Ltd. for bookings within Singapore.

INSPECTION CRITERIA: The criteria for inspection has not changed.

The inspection is to assess the vehicle for;

- a. Vehicle must not exceed the eight (8) year age limit. Based on the year of first registration, which will not be more than one year from the date of manufacture.
- b. Right hand drive vehicles only.
- c. Roadworthiness Inspection.

The vehicle must be presented with an authentic registration / deregistration card.

CERTIFICATE: JEVIC RWI Certificate can be collected from the JEVIC office, or will be dispatched COD, once the vehicle successfully passes the inspection process.
